

Using the Buckeye Corpus of Conversational Speech

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This workshop provides an introduction to using the Buckeye Corpus in linguistic research. The Buckeye Corpus is a newly developed database of casual speech containing high-quality recordings from 40 speakers in Columbus, Ohio conversing freely with an interviewer. An orthographic transcription as well as time-aligned phonetic labels, are available, along with audio files for research purposes. An overview of the corpus will be presented, and software for accessing and analyzing the corpus will be demonstrated.
